## Floral Bracelet

Floral motifs are still current. Preciosa Ornela presents a tutorial on how to assemble a floral bracelet from the popular PRECIOSA Pip ${ }^{T M}$ and PRECIOSA Pellet ${ }^{T M}$ beads. Be inspired and create your own floral accessory.
Choose suitable colors from the wide range of beads and seed beads sold under the PRECIOSA Traditional Czech Beads ${ }^{T M}$ brand.

## Materials and tools:

PRECIOSA $\operatorname{Pip}^{\mathrm{TM}}(\mathbf{P})$
$11101346 ; 5$ x 7 mm ;
02010/14457; 66x
PRECIOSA Pellet ${ }^{\mathrm{TM}}(\mathbf{P l})$
11101339 ; $4 \times 6 \mathrm{~mm}$;
23030; 11x
PRECIOSA Rocailles (R10)
33119 001; 10/o;
57290; ca 5 g
PRECIOSA Thorn ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ (Th)
$11101340 ; 5 \times 16 \mathrm{~mm}$;
23030; 3x
Rings for finishing; a carabiner;
Nymo thread or a line; a needle; scissors; pliers

You can also use PRECIOSA Thorn ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ beads in the same color as the PRECIOSA Pellet ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ for additional decorations.


## Difficulty:

Technique: stringing, basic beadweaving

## Procedure:

Step 1:
Thread the needle. String 10x R10, 1 x Pl and 10x R1o. Thread the needle through the PI.

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A loop of R10 will be created,
on which you will attach the fastening.
Do not forget to tighten the thread when
working


Step 2:
String 3x $\mathbf{P}$ and once again thread the needle through the $\mathbf{P l}$ in the same direction from the loop to the rocailles.


Step 3:
String $3 x \mathbf{P}$ again and thread the needle through the $\mathbf{P l}$ so that a flower is created.


Step 4:
Thread the needle through the following 10x R10, tie the ends and continue with the work. String $1 \mathrm{xPl}, 3 \mathrm{x} \mathbf{P}$ and thread the needle back through the Pl.


Step 5:
String $3 \times \mathbf{P}$ and thread the needle through the Pl. You have created another flower. String 10x R10.


Step 6:
String 1x Pl and 3x $\mathbf{P}$ again and thread the needle back through $\mathbf{P l}$.
Repeat the procedure according to figures 5 and 6 until you have the required length of the bracelet.


Step 7
After achieving the required length of the bracelet, string 10x R10 and thread the needle back through the $\mathbf{P l}$. This will create a loop for the fastening. Sew the thread in firmly and tie several knots. Cut off the thread.

## Step 8:

Use the flat nose pliers to attach the fastening - the ring and the carabiner. You can use Th beads to additionally decorate the end of the bracelet with the rings.


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
