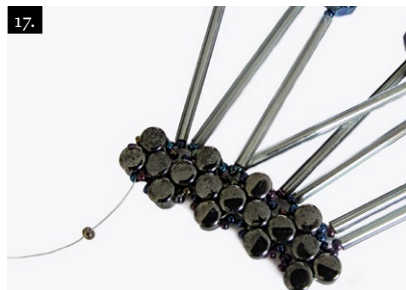

NECKLACE MADE USING PRECIOSA BUGLES

Romana Tschunková's impressive necklace makes use of the options presented by combining beads and seed beads from the PRECIOSA Traditional Czech Beads™ brand.

The basic ruff is sewn using dainty PRECIOSA Pellet™ pressed beads in combination with rocailles. The long bugles around the circumference then highlight the cut semi-sphere of the PRECIOSA Hill™.

Materials and tools:

a metal fastening of your own choice; a stringing needle; thread (Fireline, Nymo, Ove 6...); scissors

Difficulty:

Procedure:

Step 1:
String 3x P, pull them into a circle and tie a knot (fig. 1).



Step 2:
Pull the needle through the nearest P (fig. 2).



Step 3:
String 2x P and thread the needle back through the 1st P (fig. 3).



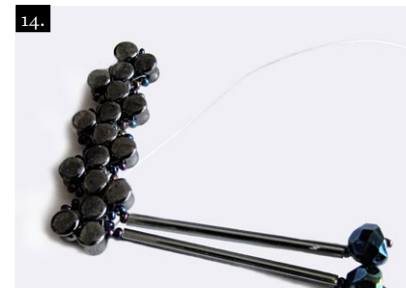
Step 4:
Continue in this manner until you achieve the required length of the necklace (figs. 4 + 5).



Step 5:
Thread the needle through the hole in the last P (fig. 6), string 2x R11, thread the needle into the hole of the following P (fig. 7), continue until the end of the necklace and thread the needle through the P and both R11 (figs. 8 + 9 + 10).



Step 6:
String 1x R11, 1x B, 1x R11, 1x H and 1x R11 (fig. 11), thread the needle back through the H, R11, B, R11 (fig. 12). String 1x R11, 1x B, 1x R11, 1x H and 1x R11 again (fig. 13) and return with the needle to the H, R11, B, R11 and then through the R11 and the adjacent P (fig. 14). Continue in the same way up to the end of the basic stringing. Thread the needle into the top left P (fig. 15).



Step 7:
Thread the needle through the P - R11 (fig. 16), string 1x R10 (fig. 17), thread the line through the next R11 and the adjacent P. Continue to the end (fig. 18), tighten the stringing and tie a knot, hide the knot in the nearest hole. Attach the fastening of your choice.
