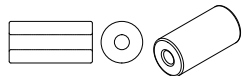

# Drizzle

## Materials and tools:

### PRECIOSA Rola™ (RO)

341 59 001; 10 x 5 mm;  
78102 silver plated;  
the necklace: 13x; the creole earrings: 10x,  
simple: 2x



### PRECIOSA Drops (D)

331 11 001; 5/0;  
78102 silver plated;  
the necklace: 13x; creole earrings: 10x,  
simple: 2x



### PRECIOSA Rocailles (R)

331 19 001; 8/0;  
78102 silver plated;  
the necklace: 246x; the creole earrings 86x,  
simple: 2x



a thin dense chain; an adjusting chain;  
a 4 mm ring; a ring made from thin 5 mm wire;  
steel necklace memory wire; a carabiner  
a 2.5 cm diameter wire creole; earring hooks



a 0.20 mm nylon line; a ruler; round-nosed  
pliers; flat-nosed pliers (for handling the rings);  
large snipping pliers

**Difficulty:** 1/4

## Procedure:

### Step 1:

Cut off pieces of chain in the following lengths:  
1x 8 cm and then 2x 7 cm, 6 cm, 5 cm, 4 cm, 3 cm  
and 2 cm.



### Step 2:

Tie an RO and an R to the end of the chain.  
String 1x R, 1x RO and the outer link  
of the chain. Thread the line back through  
the RO again in the opposite direction.  
Tie off the line with three knots.  
Thread the needle with the line through the RO.  
Gently but firmly jiggle the line so that the knot  
moves into the hole. Cut off the line.



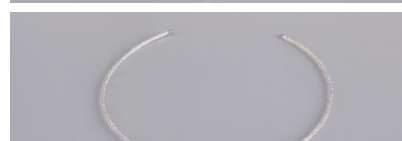
### Step 3:

Thread a D onto the thin ring. Tread the ring  
through the hole in the R under the RO.  
Close the ring.



### Step 4:

Twist a loop into the memory wire.  
String 100x R. String the 2 cm chain behind  
the empty outer link. String 3x R.  
Continue adding the other chains, first in  
ascending then in descending order.  
Always add 3x R between them.  
String 100x R after the last chain.  
Twist a loop.



### Step 5:

Attach the fastening. Attach the carabiner  
to one loop using a 4 mm ring.  
Cut off 16 cm of adjusting chain.  
Attach both outer loops to an empty link  
in the chain using a 4 mm ring.



### Creole earrings

Cut off 2x 4 cm lengths of chain and 4x 3 cm  
and 2 cm lengths. Attach an RO and an R  
to the end link. Add rings with D.  
String about 13x R on the creole wire.  
Add the empty outer link of the chains  
by length and string 3x R between them.  
String a further 13x R onto the wire.  
Thread the end into the tube in the creole wire.  
Crimp the tube using round-nosed  
pliers.



### Simple earrings

Cut off 2x 6 cm of chain. Attach an RO and  
an R to the outer chain links. Add rings with  
D. Attach the earring hooks to the empty  
end links.
